Application for a biodiversity conservation licence and registration of premises to trade in live reptiles

**Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 and Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017** 

## Definitions for this animal dealer (live reptile) licence class

**Animal dealer** means a person who buys, sells or trades in native animals and exercises or carries on the business of an animal dealer at a registered premises associated with an animal dealer licence.

**Animal dealer licence** means a class of biodiversity conservation licence granted under Part 2 of the Act authorising a person to buy, sell or trade in native animals.

**Pet shop** means a premise used for the retail sale of animals to the public, excluding residential premises.

**Registered premises** means premises (pet shop) registered under the BC Act and the Regulations at which the holder of an animal dealer licence can buy, sell or trade in native animals.

Reptile means a reptile as defined in Schedule 5 of the BC Act.

The BC Act means the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016.

The Regulation means the Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017.

The Department means the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment
