General Licence to Harm Protected Animals (Airport)

Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

Licence conditions

1. Only the authorised person(s) named to perform the activity allowed by this licence may undertake the activity allowed by this licence.
2. The licensee must maintain a true, accurate and up-to-date record of all protected animals harmed under the terms of this licence. A report of all protected animals harmed (species and number) must be received by the Wildlife Team at the end of the licence term.
3. A copy of the records, referred to in condition 2. must be provided for inspection on request by an authorised officer of National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS).
4. An authorised person operating under this licence must comply with any direction given by an authorised officer of NPWS.
5. May only harm animals in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedures or Code of Practice relevant to the species being harmed.
6. The licensee must promptly alleviate the suffering of any injured protected animals by quick and humane euthanasia of the animal.
7. Where possible, control activities should be conducted out of sight of the public.
8. The licensee is to bury the carcasses of the protected animals shot on the lands specified in this licence at a single location, which is readily identified
