
What YOU need to do to have the best chance of being awarded funding?





Ecological restoration programs

Trust programs available for on-ground ecological restoration projects



Protecting our Places (up to \$60,000 over 3 years)

Annual Programs

(up to \$100,000 over 3 years)

One-off Programs



Community capacity building programs

Trust programs available for annual community capacity building projects



Environmental Research (up to \$200,000 over 3 years)

Environmental Education (up to \$60,000 over 3 years OR up to \$250,000 over 5 years)

Lead Environmental Community Groups (up to \$70,000/year)

Eco Schools
(up to \$3,500 over 2 years)



Contestable Programs funding allocation Restoration & Rehabilitation

- R&R Community / Government \$4 million/year
- Protecting our Places \$700,000/year
- Saving our Species Partnerships \$10 million (multi-year)
- Saving our Species Contestables \$9 million (one-off)
- Community Bush Regeneration \$8 million (one-off)
- Bush Connect \$8 million (one-off)

Environmental Education

- Education Community / Government \$1 million/year
- Eco Schools \$280,000/year
- Lead Environmental Community Groups \$600,000/year

Environmental Research

Research - \$1 million/year

Approximately 600 active projects worth \$55 million at any one time.



















Tips for increasing your chances of getting funding

- Identify the environmental issue or problem
- 2. Be clear on why it's a problem and why it needs to be fixed
- 3. Work out what needs to happen to fix that issue or problem
- 4. Work out how (and if) you could fix that problem
- 5. Identify anyone else who needs to be involved
- 6. Take the time to properly plan the project (what, how, who, when, etc)
- 7. Determine how much it will cost to fix the problem (realistic budget)
- 8. Investigate your funding options

Then, and only then.....

9. Apply for Trust funding
