Final Determination

The Scientific Committee, established by the *Threatened Species Conservation Act* 1995, has made a Final Determination to reject a proposal to list a population of the Koala *Phascolarctos cinereus* (Goldfuss, 1817) in the Tweed local government area east of the Pacific Highway as an ENDANGERED POPULATION in the Schedules of the Act.

The Scientific Committee has found that:

- 1. A Preliminary Determination supporting a proposal to list the Koala, *Phascolarctos cinereus* (Goldfuss, 1817) in the Tweed local government area east of the Pacific Highway was placed on public exhibition from 24 October 2014 to 30 January 2015. The Committee received a number of submissions.
- 2. In view of the issues raised in submissions the Committee has decided to amend the boundary of the population.
- 3. The amended boundary includes an additional area not covered in the previous Preliminary Determination. As a result the Committee will make a further Preliminary Determination to support a proposal to list a population of the Koala *Phascolarctos cinereus* (Goldfuss, 1817) between the Tweed and Brunswick Rivers east of the Pacific Highway as an endangered population. The Preliminary Determination will be placed on public exhibition for comment.
